

PELHAM. N. H.

The Federal Radio commission at Washington has just issued call letters for amateur radio station operation here in Pelham. William S. Koehler of Bridge street has the call W-IDY and Rev. Norman S. Davis has W1IDR.

For those who do not know about the regulations on radio communication, the letters signify the following: W for the United States; 1, the district in which Pelham is located, and the three letters following designate the respective station calls, as, IDY for Mr. Koehler, and IDR for Rev. Mr. Davis. Both have their stations in operation and have worked other stations here and outside of New England. All operation is on short wave and does not interfere with any of the regular radio programs on the ordinary home radio. As far as is known, these are the first call letters ever to be issued in this town to any person. These licenses permit both 'phone and telegraph operation.
