

Mrs. Catherine F. Donovan

Funeral services for Mrs. Catherine F. Donovan were held from the home, Mammoth road, Tuesday morning, at 8.30 followed by a solemn high funeral mass at St. Patrick's church, Pelham, at 9.30 o'clock. Rev. Cornelius F. Cahill, pastor, officiated at the services, assisted by Rev. John Boyd of Lebanon, as deacon, and Rev. P. J. Kennedy of Salem, N. H. as sub-deacon.

Whalen's mass was sung by Mrs. Florence Palermo and Mrs. LaFontaine with Mrs. Lafontaine at the organ.

As the body was taken in and out of the church a guard of honor was formed by members of the Catholic Women's club. Members of Pelham Grange and the local Parent-Teacher association attended.
