Pelham, March 3.—The sudden death of Henry A. Jones of this town last Friday afternoon, came as a great shock to his townspeople. His age was 72 years, one month and 21 days. His active life and business associations had gained him an extra large circle of friends and he was widely known in this state and in Massachusetts, also having extensive business interests in Maine. On the day of his death Mr. Jones had visited Lowell, apparently in his usual good health and on returning spent the balance of the afternoon, as was his wont, playing cards and spending the time in a pleasant social manner, with his family. Suddenly arising from the card table where engaged, he took but a few steps when he grasped the back of another chair and sank upon it dying with hardly a struggle. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Abbie J. (Richardson) Jones, two daughters, Mrs. Arthur M. Butler and Miss Bessie F. Jones and three sons, Avery M. Jones, Elijah R. Jones and Albert H. Jones, all of this town.
