

# Gunner On Navy Plane Killed In African Area

**Charles E. Pariseau, Jr., 19, Native of This City, Met  
Death in Performance of His Duty Navy  
Department Notifies Parents**

While at his gunner's post in a U. S. Navy plane operating from an North African base, 19-year-old Charles E. Pariseau Jr., former Lawrence boy, was killed in the performance of his duty according to a telegram received from the Navy Department by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Charles E. Pariseau, Darby road, Pelham, N. H. The young aviation ordnance man, third class, has been serving with a patrol squadron that has been shuttling ammunition from North Africa to the front.

Date of death and location of the tragedy were not included in the government wire. The father of the boy who was called from his duties in a Worcester war plant to open the telegram.
