

Pelham Sailor War Casualty

Charles E. Pariseau, Jr.,
Lost in Mediterranean

PELHAM, N. H., Nov. 1—Mr. and Mrs. Charles E. Pariseau of Marsh road, Pelham, temporarily residing in Worcester, Mass., have been notified by the war department of the death of their son, Charles E. Pariseau, Jr., seaman first class.

He was killed in action in a plane crash somewhere in the Mediterranean. The plane was engaged in transport duty, carrying ammunition to a point in Italy, when it was destroyed and all on board were killed.

He was a member of Pelham Congregational church and a memorial service will be held for him during the morning church service next Sunday.
