

## 1862 Census

In the midst of the American Civil War, or as we say in New Hampshire, the War of the Rebellion, the Pelham Board of Selectmen, conducted a census of all able bodied male residents of Pelham. Philip R. Currier, past President of the Pelham Historical Society, caused that list to be reproduced from original town records. That list follows:

### The Second Selectmen's List.

This list is printed in its entirety since it includes ages and occupations.

"Enrollment of all the able bodied male citizens in the town of Pelham in the County of Hillsborough in the State of New Hampshire made by the Selectmen August 20, 1862."
